Vince emigrated to the United States with his family in 1957 and naturalized as a citizen a few years later. He graduated from Long Island City High School in Astoria, NY and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from St. Francis College in Brooklyn, NY. Upon graduation, he served in the US Army as a Communications Specialist with the Special Operations group (Green Beret). He was honorably discharged at the rank of Sergeant. Upon return from his tour of Vietnam he met and married his great love, Marie. Together they raised a family including daughter, Claudine and son, Adam. While delighting in their 51 years together travelling, skiing, playing chess, enjoying country music and opera, Vince built an almost 40 year career at Princewaterhouse Coopers, retiring as a partner of the firm. In the years following his "retirement" he enjoyed working with several different companies, reading about history and philosophy, and learning to play guitar.
